

- Please select all of the following reasons that indicate why you like your preferred study spot.



What time of day is your "study time?




Which of the following days of the week do you study?






Ranking #10f Preferred Study Spot




Ranking #2 of Preferred Study Spot






Ranking #3 of Preferred Study Spot

Survey Notes

Listed below are points collected from the data listed above.

- The main choice of studying times for Butler students was in the evenings
 (4PM-8PM) with 91 of 268 votes. Second most common are later evenings
 (8PM-12AM) with 79 of 268 votes. Third most common are afternoons
 (12PM-4PM) with 68 of 533 votes.
- Butler students generally study on **Wednesdays** the most with 115 of 613 votes choosing this option. Then following sequentially: Tuesdays and Mondays.
- Majority choose **Irwin Library** as either their first choice (33 of 139) or as their second choice (25 of 136).
- For first choice on studying location, **Irwin Librar**y came up with the majority of votes with **My Place of Residence** and **Dugan Hall** coming up in second and third preference respectively.
- SGA offered a write in option for the studying locations in case someone had a different preferred location. In this option, **CTS** had the most votes The top reasons for choosing a preferred studying spot were that it allowed students to be **quiet and focused** (117 out of 533), it has a **calming feel** (90 of 533), and it is **less crowded** (83 of 533).

Next Steps

SGA is actively working toward addressing student concerns and feedback.

- Relaying feedback to Irwin Library in hopes of lengthening hours. (10/9)
- Working collaboratively with Butler faculty to see how we can maintain open library times during peak studying periods.
- Irwin Library shared they will be hiring for a nighttime supervisor (10/18)
- Irwin Library will work on better marketing/branding of spaces/services (10/18)
